### **Day 1: Tuesday, 05 July 2022**

TIME TBC	Arrival at London St Pancras International.
08:30	Check in at St Pancras Eurostar terminal.
09:31	Depart St Pancras for Paris Gare du Nord on Eurostar
12:57	Arrive at Paris Gare du Nord Take public transport from Gare du Nord to the hotel
Approx 14:00	Arrive at hotel and check in
Afternoon	1 Hour Return Boat Cruise on River Seine
Afternoon	Free time around Eiffel Tower (Payable locally) and Champs-Elysee
Evening	2 Course evening Meal with Soft Drink at Monte Carlo Restaurant Return to accommodation and overnight in Paris

### **Day 2: Wednesday, 06 July 2022**

Breakfast	Continental breakfast will be served at the hotel.
Morning	Depart the accommodation. Take RER for Disneyland Paris
